## CONSIDERATE PARKING AROUND THE HALL

Significant inconvenience can be caused to residents and users of the hall, particularly those with special needs, due to inconsiderate parking.

We would like to remind neighbours and visitors with vehicles to park ONLY in permitted locations, giving the greatest consideration to the needs of the elderly and disabled, as well as ensuring that residents' access to their homes is not blocked.

Please be aware of the following DOs and DON'Ts:-

- DON'T park on the pavement under any circumstances. Obstructing the pavement is a criminal offence which can be reported to the police.
- DON'T block access to residents' driveways or garages
- DON'T park for an extended period directly outside the Old Schoolroom front door. This is a pick-up/drop-off access space ONLY.
- DON'T obstruct the stretch of lowered pavement at the front of the hall, which is provided to facilitate disabled access.
- DO allow enough space for public service vehicles such as ambulances, buses and refuse vehicles to pass between cars parked on both sides of the High Street

We are all only too aware of the limited parking space in the High Street, particularly

when building works are going on. But if we try to follow the guidance above,
everyone will enjoy a better experience.
