 5. 1 Marrow (not large courgette)
 6. 2 Squash (same variety)
 7. 3 Tomatoes (with stalks do not polish)
 8. 3 Cherry Tomatoes (with stalks, do not polish)
 9. 3 different Salad crops (1 of each), on a plate
 10. 2 Any other Vegetable (same variety), on a plate*
 11. 3 Ripe Apples (same variety)*
 12. Plate of Soft Fruit (e.g. Raspberries)*
 13. 6 Any other Fruit (single type), on a plate*
 14. Selection of Culinary Herbs (1 stem of each)
 15. Longest Runner Bean
